

Design of Danish National Champion jersey

Introduction

This manual defines the design specifications and commercial rules for the Danish National Champion Jersey won at the National Championships in the disciplines Road, Track, MTB, BMX, Cyclocross and Trial.

Every national or international club or team with a Danish National Champion is allowed to design a Danish National Champion jersey including the commercial partners of the club or team.

UCI regulations for National Champion's jersey

The general rules of the Danish National Champion jersey are in accordance with the rules stated by the UCI.

§ 7 National champion's jersey

- 1.3.068** National champions must wear their jersey in all events in the discipline, speciality and category in which they won their title and no other event until the evening of the day before the commencement of the next edition of the national championships of said discipline, speciality and category.

The national champion in the individual time trial is not authorised to wear the distinctive national champion's jersey during team time trial events.

In Madison track races if one of the teammates is not national champion, then both riders shall wear the same team jersey. In a six-day event, only madison national champions must wear the jersey even if they are not paired together.

(N) When he no longer holds the title of national champion, a rider can wear piping in national colours on the collar and cuffs of his jersey and shorts as per the technical specifications determined by the national federation. However, he can wear such a jersey only in events of the discipline, speciality and category in which he won the title and in no other event; nevertheless, former individual time trial national champion is authorised to use piping in national colour on his time trial skinsuit for individual time trial and team time trial events.

The national champion jersey must be worn whenever a rider is engaged in activities on the track, awards ceremonies, press conferences, television interviews, autograph sessions and other occasions which require a good presentation.

The official Danish National Champion jersey

An official Danish National Champion jersey, and the right and duty to wear it, is won in the following disciplines for U19 (juniors), U23 (Espoirs) and Men and Women Elite:

Road

Road Race
Time Trial

Track (only U19 and Men and Women Elite)

For the disciplines where Danish Championships are held

MTB

Cross Country (XCO)
Marathon (XCM)

BMX

BMX Racing

Cyclocross

Trial (only Men Elite)

Danish National Champion jersey design specifications

The Danish National Champion jersey design must be based on a red jersey with a white cross.

The white cross shall be incorporated, so that the horizontal white line of the cross is placed on the chest and back of the jersey.

The white cross shall be incorporated, so that the vertical white line of the cross passes the exact middle of the jersey running from the top to the bottom of the jersey.

The width of the stripes of the white cross shall be exactly 100 mm (10 cm) both vertical and horizontal.

On the long sleeve jersey, the sleeves shall have the same red color as the jersey in general.

It is possible to add two white stripes with the same width, separated by the red jersey color, on the neck, on the end of the short or long sleeves of the jersey and on the end of the bib shorts.



The width of possible stripes on the end of short and long sleeves shall be not more than 10 mm (1 cm).

Colors

The red and white colors of the Danish Championship jersey shall be the following:

Red – Pantone

185C (standard red) or 201 C (Danish National team red.)

White – Pantone

Standard fabric white

Manufacturers brand logo

There must be only one manufacturer brand logo on the jersey. So, if there is one manufacturer brand logo on the front, no manufacturer brand logos are allowed on the back and vice versa.

The manufacturer brand logo shall have the maximum size of 25 cm² (5x5 cm).

No manufacturer brand logos are allowed on the neck or sleeves.

The zipper mover can take form as a manufacturer brand logo.

Commercial logos

On the front and on the back of the Danish National Champion jersey the main sponsor logo can be placed in a size of maximum 10 cm height and 30 cm width.

Other commercial logos with smaller sizes than the main sponsor logo can be placed on the front, back, side, sleeves, and neck of the Danish National Champion jersey.

Approval of Danish National Champion jerseys

When the first draft of the Danish National Champion jersey is ready, the club or team forward it to the Danish Cycling Federation for approval. The design is then assessed by the Technical Commission and the Head of Performance of the federation to clarify if the jersey can be approved or not. If the jersey can't be approved, the federation clarifies the details that should be changed. The club or team will then adjust the design and forward the second draft of the jersey.

When the jersey can be approved, the club or team can continue to production of the jersey.

Remarks

All former Danish National Champions are allowed to include a Danish flag or red/white stripes on the sleeves and/or neck of future club/team jerseys. But only on the jersey of the discipline in which the rider is former Danish National Champion.
